Day 1	Arrive in Guatemala City
Tuesday, July 21	Arrive on your inbound flight to Guatemala City - La Aurora International Airport.  Group lunch and transfer from airport to Antigua.  Welcome gathering and dinner.

Day 2	Patulul & Tolimán
Wednesday, July 22	We start our Sojourn with a visit to a local artisan group in Patulul where we will participate in their beautiful Dream Circle.
	In the afternoon we will transfer from Patulul to Hotel Tolimán.
Accommodations	Hotel Tolimán
Meals Included (B, L, D)	Breakfast at Hotel Eterna Primavera. Lunch at Patulul. Dinner at Hotel Tolimán.



Day 3	Atitlan Natural Reserve & Rincon Suizo Farm
Thursday, July 23	After a morning excursion exploring Atitlan Natural Reserve we'll enjoy a boat trip across Lake Atitlan to Panajachel.  In the afternoon we'll learn about local agriculture at Rincon Suizo Farm before we transfer to Antigua.  We'll enjoy a night sleeping in "el cielo" in unique airstream trailers and cabins and gather to enjoy the views!
Accommodations	Santo Cielo by Casa Santo Domingo
Meals Included (B, L, D)	Breakfast at Hotel Tolimán. Lunch at the farm if time allows. Dinner at Epicure.



Day 4	School Visit & Explore Antigua
Friday, July 24	This morning we will visit a private school and the children can connect with one another through activities and translations and share a lunch together.  You will have the afternoon and evening free to explore and dine with members of the group or on your own. You may wish to enjoy the luxurious spa at Casa Santo Domingo or visit one of the museums on the hotel property.

Day 5	Antigua
Saturday, July 25	We'll spend our morning in Antigua visiting a fair trade artisan group and the women will teach us how to make our own bracelets.  After lunch we'll visit a chocolate museum where you'll learn about the chocolate prices and it's origin and then have the opportunity to craft our own chocolate.  In the evening we'll enjoy our farewell dinner and have a closing gathering to celebrate all that we experienced and learned during our Sojourn.
